Description

SARAWANA was job number 1094 from the Halvorsen's yard at Ryde in NSW and launched in July 1954. It is an early 26 footer (7.9 metres) from the builders and possibly the second of that length that they built. The craft was originally named FOAM and was privately owned. This 26 foot length type soon became the backbone of the hire fleet. SARAWANA is planked in oregon with a maple and teak cabin. The varnished superstructure and white hull is the typical finish for a Halvorsen and these small craft share the same Halvorsen elegance of their larger companions. SARAWANA has a side opening door which may not be a typical feature on the hire craft versions at this length. The motor cruiser has remained in good condition under a number of private owners, and had the original petrol motor replaced with a diesel in 1969.
