Description

JESAMINE has a carvel planked hull with a spoon bow profile, and the raked transom associated with the 21 Foot Restricted Class rules. The profile has a shorter overhang

at the stem and deeper forefoot than other craft more orientated to racing purposes. It now has an oval shaped cockpit which was more suitable for its fishing days. JESAMINE only raced for a short period. It represented Victoria in the 1924 series for The Forster Cup but did not feature in any high placings. In the lead up to the racing it was suggested it would be at its best in lighter winds. In 2010 JESAMINE retains its gaff rig and has been overhauled and restored for use as a recreational pleasure boat with the rare distinction of being able to race with the couta boat fleet or to race as a 21 Foot Restricted Class yacht. It was restored by 'Dugga' Beazley, a popular identity and fisherman from Port Phillip, but is now owned by a descendant of the builder.
